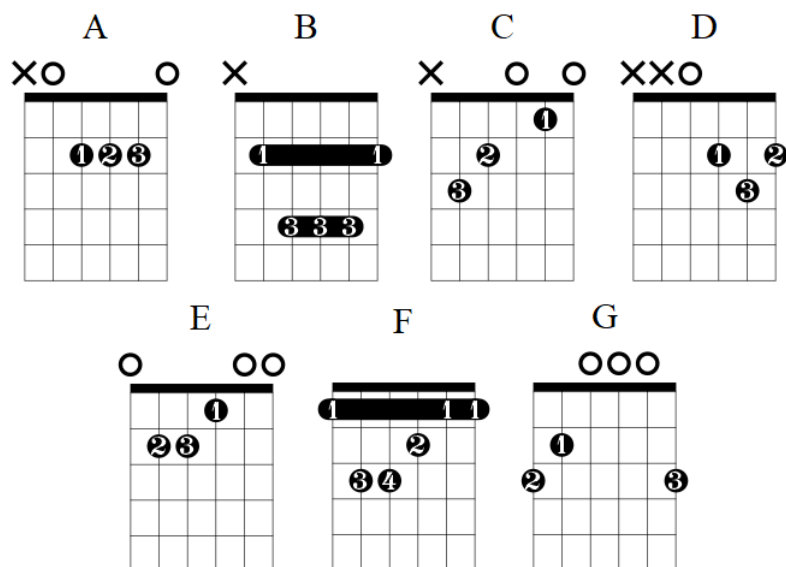


Sittin On The Dock Of The Bay by Otis Redding



Make sure to listen to the song because some of the chords are going to change on the upstrum and be held through the next measure as shown below. Walkdowns can also be added when going from the C chord to the A chord if you play the entire song as barre chords.

Strumming Option 1:

G B
 1 + 2 + 3 + 4 + 1 + 2 + 3 + 4 +
 D DU DU DU UD DUDU

Strumming Option 2:

G B
 1 + a 2 + 3 + 4 + 1 + 2 + a 3 + 4 +
 D UDU DU DU UD U DU DU

VERSE:
