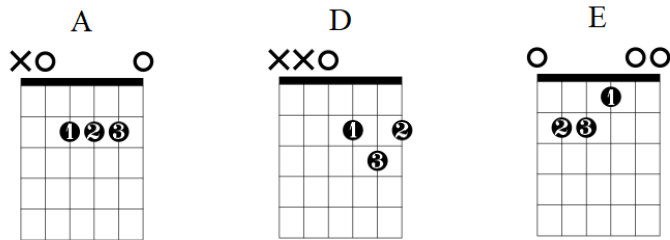


Kansas City by Fats Domino

Player Notes:

This is a great beginner song and is played using a 12-Bar blues pattern. So once you play through 12 bars, or measures of music, you play the pattern all over again from the beginning. This song only uses three chords: A, D and E.

That's what makes this song such a great beginner guitar song. As with all songs, beginners can use 4 down strums or the strumming pattern above.
